

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Day

The fifty-day season of Easter concludes with the celebration of the coming of the Holy Spirit. On Pentecost, we celebrate God's constant presence in all who believe, for we trust that the Holy Spirit remains with us always, guiding our lives, animating our souls, and flowing through us to bear fruit in the world. Indeed, today and every Sunday the Holy Spirit draws us here to together give thanks and praise to God for the wondrous gifts we have been given.

Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

The readings from the Old Testament that we hear tonight tell stories from different points in the era before Christ that give us a glimpse of what the world was like without the Holy Spirit in it. People found it difficult to communicate, God was hidden and unintelligible to most people, and after death, nothing remained of those who died but dry bones. Saint Paul writes of that world "groaning in labor pains," suffering while anticipating the birth of new life. Finally, Jesus anticipates the day when the Holy Spirit will flow through those who believe. May we recognize the Holy Spirit in our midst as we listen to God's word.





<u>Upright Monument Lots:</u> NO PERRENIALS (plants that grow from year to year). Planting of <u>only</u> annual flowers, is permitted in front of the base of the monument in the 12" area on the burial side. <u>NO Shrubbery or bushes</u> of any kind (including Azalea and Rose bushes). <u>NO Hosts or Pachysandra, NO WOODCHIPS, MULCH, stones, fences, vases, statues, balloons, or bric-brac of any description.</u>

Use dirt or topsoil ONLY

Non Monument Lots - (single graves, footstone) Potted Plant or flower box, placed on the footstone, will be allowed for only 7 days after a holiday. Anything dug into the soil will be immediately removed. If you have any questions or doubts, please call the Rectory at (203) 235-6341 and we will be very happy to help you. 
Corpus Christi Procession




